

A. The Paragraph:	
1) Has a topic sentence that addresses the question through a clear argument	
2) Has an argument within the paragraph that relates to the question, but this argument is not clear from the opening sentence	
3) Is not clearly related to the question	

If you ticked #2 above, what topic sentence do you think the writer could have used to effectively answer the question? (You can use some words from the middle of the paragraph to assist if you would like to)

B. The Paragraph:	
1) Has effective evidence from both texts that justifies the argument being made	
2) Has used evidence from one text that justifies the argument being made	
3) Has used evidence but has not clearly connected the evidence to the argument being made	
4) Had not used any evidence	

C. The Paragraph:	
1) Ends by drawing a clear connection between the paragraph and the question	
2) Would benefit from a clearer connection between the argument presented and the question	
3) Is not clearly related to the question
